

Commercial Concrete Walls

The installation of a concrete wall requires a building permit. Before a permit can be issued, you must submit a permit application, along with a site plan of the property, and a cross-section of the work. Once these plans are approved, a building permit will be issued. The permit applicant must be either a licensed builder or the location's property owner.

Below is a rough diagram showing how the wall must be constructed and how it must cascade at the last 25 feet of the ends. Footing and final inspections required.

Walls must be constructed out of monolithic, brick embossed concrete or precast construction (brick embossed panels). Plank wall systems are not allowed. See ordinance 15.508, sec. 35.81 for more information.
